

# EQUIPMENT DIVISION RULES

## **OPEN**

This is the race division. All legal firearms are allowed. Optics, compensators, and any safe holster/position are specifically allowed.

## **LIMITED**

Any iron-sighted pistol without a compensator, barrel ports, or optical sight. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed.

## **PRODUCTION**

Production Division is strictly limited to the use of production handguns with actions that are double-action-only, double-action/single-action or striker-fired – mostly in the caliber of 9mm. These are the “duty guns” available from nearly every pistol maker and each of the major manufacturers offers a wide variety of models that meet USPSA Production Division requirements.

## **SINGLE STACK**

This division caters to the 1911 purist and thus requires barrel bushings for barrels over 4.25". No race holsters allowed and the holster and mag pouches must be carried behind your hip bones. Iron sights of the notch and post design only for this divisions only. No compensators or ported barrels allowed.

## **REVOLVER**

Any iron sighted revolver without a compensator, barrel ports or optical sight. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed. No barrel length or holster restrictions.

## **OPEN REVOLVER**

Optics & Ports/Compensators

## **CARRY OPTICS**

Any Semi-Auto pistol that is legal in Production Division that is under 35oz. Carry Optic firearms are allowed a slide mounted optic between the rear of the breech face and the rear of the slide. The weight limit includes the firearm AND optic.

## **RIMFIRE PISTOL IRONS (RFPI)**

Any iron-sighted pistol shooting .22 LR ammunition only and without a compensator or barrel ports. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed. Starting position is from low-ready and the firearm must be transported between stages in a holster or case.

## **RIMFIRE PISTOL OPTICS (RFPO)**

Any pistol shooting .22 LR ammunition only. Compensators and/or barrel ports are permitted. Use a red-dot sight permitted. Starting position is from low-ready and the rifle must be transported between stages in a holster or case.

## **RIMFIRE RIFLE IRONS (RFRI)**

Any iron-sighted rifle shooting .22 LR ammunition only and without a compensator or barrel ports. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed. Starting position is from low-ready and the rifle must be transported between stages in a case.

**RIMFIRE RIFLE OPTICS (RFRO)**

Any rifle shooting .22 LR ammunition only. Compensators or barrel ports are allowed. Use of red-dot sight permitted. Starting position is from low-ready and the rifle must be transported between stages in a case.

**PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE IRONS (PCCI)**

Any iron sight pistol caliber carbine chambered in 9mm/.40 S&W/.45 ACP. Use of fiber optic sight specifically permitted. Starting position is from low-ready and the rifle must be transported between stages in a case.

**PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE OPTICS (PCCO)**

Any pistol caliber carbine chambered in 9mm/.40 S&W/.45 ACP. Use of red dot optical sight permitted. Starting position is from low-ready and the rifle must be transported between stages in a case.
